4. Entitlement to a surviving partner's pension

The entitlement to a surviving partner's pension exists if, at the member's death:

- ▶ the partners shared a common life and destiny similar to marriage and cohabited for an uninterrupted period of at least 5 years immediately prior to the member's death, or were cohabiting with the member immediately prior to the member's death and were responsible for the maintenance of at least one of the couple's child,
- ▶ the two partners are neither married, nor related (within the meaning of Article 95 of Swiss Civil Code),
- ▶ the two partners are not registered partners within the meaning of LPart/PartG,
- ▶ the surviving partner does not receive a spouse's or partner's pension from a prior marriage or partnership,
- ▶ this statement must have been duly signed and completed by both partners and forwarded to the Pension Fund prior the member's death.

5. Remarks/Confirmation

Members who are drawing a full disability pension on 31.12.2009 are not entitled to a surviving partner's pension.

The Pension Fund will not examine entitlements to a partner's benefits during the member's lifetime. It is for the surviving partner to prove that he/she satisfies all the requirements at the member's death.

The member undertakes to notify the Pension Fund promptly upon the termination of his cohabitation with the partner indicated in point 2.
